
About 4D

The worktop of a kitchen is one of the most important components and must be chosen carefully, as most preparation is carried out on it. The choice of the material to be used is vital and, in the range of materials available on the market, porcelain stoneware is certainly among the best thanks to its technical and aesthetic features.

RESISTANCE TO HEAT

Surfaces in porcelain stoneware resist high temperatures, frost and thermal shock. These characteristics are fundamental in a kitchen, as frequent contact with any hot pots and tools may damage the countertop. High temperatures and sudden thermal changes do not affect this material in any way over time thanks to its high technical performance.

RESISTANCE TO SCRATCHES

As the countertop is intensively used in a kitchen, it may be scratched or scored very often by sharp or pointed tools, but also by rough everyday objects. Porcelain stoneware is definitely the hardest material among those available on the market; due to its natural resistance, it is the ideal choice for avoiding this kind of damage and always having a perfect top that will not change over time in the kitchen.

RESISTANCE TO STAINS AND CORROSION AND EASE OF CLEANING

Porcelain stoneware offers important characteristics such as extreme compactness and non-porosity, which make it the ideal choice for a kitchen countertop. As this material is impenetrable, even the most difficult stains can be easily removed: not only oil, wine, sauces and coffee, but also acidic substances such as lemon, vinegar or residues of detergents can be cleaned off without effort.

The environmental impact is reduced as chemical products must be used in limited quantities for cleaning porcelain stoneware surfaces, and this also preserves their original beauty over time.

SURFACE HYGIENE

Scientific evidence shows that very porous materials foster bacterial proliferation more than non-porous materials. As porcelain stoneware is a compact, non-porous material, it is particularly recommended for the surfaces of a kitchen, above all for those particularly attentive to hygiene. Health is extremely important as well, that's why SapienStone porcelain stoneware is NSF certified.

Care and Maintenance for SapienStone

SapienStone surfaces require very little maintenance. Routine cleaning with a sponge and soapy water is usually all that is needed. For streaks use a window or glass cooktop cleaner. Ex. Windex or ZAP Glass Cleaner For tougher stains see the following:

DRIED ON FOOD STAINS:

Use a Non-Abrasive gel cleaner with bleach (SOFT SCRUB WITH BLEACH) on a No-Scratch blue scrubber pad.

BUILT UP STAINS:

Use a smooth flat edge scraper against the surface to pop off any materials stuck to the SapienStone. Use appropriate cleaner for residue.

GREASY STAINS:

Use a food grade degreaser or solvent (example:Simple Green

GLUE, RUBBER MARKS:

Acetone, Lacquer thinner, Goof Off, Denatured Alcohol

RUST, METAL MARKS:

Oxalic acid based cleanser with a wet rag or sponge using very light pressure. Barkeepers Friend is recommended for most of the above tough stains or marks.

Do not leave cleaners sitting on the surface of SapienStone for extended periods of time, and always follow with mild soap and water to ensure the surface is clean and neutral when done. Use of harsh cleaners and aggressive scouring could alter the sheen of SapienStone surfaces.

It is recommended to cut food on cutting boards instead of directly on SapienStone.

Flat edge Cutlery is likely to leave a metal mark on the surface and immediately dull the knife.
